NEEDS

Ongoing advances in the basic and clinical sciences important to the practice of pediatrics and the need for clinicians to practice evidence-based medicine necessitate that CME courses offer up-to-date educational information. Physician recertification by the American Board of Pediatrics makes it imperative that course attendees be provided information necessary to help fulfill stated requirements. The majority of topics selected for inclusion in the course are based upon requests made by previous course attendees and by the American Academy of Pediatrics 2008 PREP Curriculum Content Specifications and Study Guide.

OBJECTIVES

At the conclusion of the activity, participants should be able to:

- Explain the appropriate screening for dyslipidemias and the management of pediatric patients
- Describe the appropriate and timely administration of recent FDA-approved and Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP)-recommended pediatric vaccines
- Manage appropriately community-acquired methicillin-resistant *Staphylococcus aureus* infection in pediatric patients
- Discuss with parents/guardians the newly recommended daily maintenance dose of vitamin D
- Diagnose and correctly manage gastroesophageal reflux of childhood
- Explain the pros and cons for the use or non-use of prophylactic antibiotics in children with vesicoureteral reflux
- Identify newly recognized viruses causing respiratory disease in childhood
