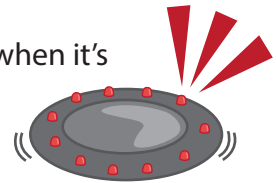

While I am in the reception room, I can read books, listen to music or watch a movie.



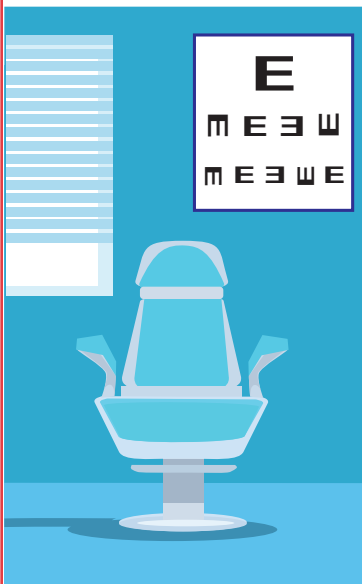

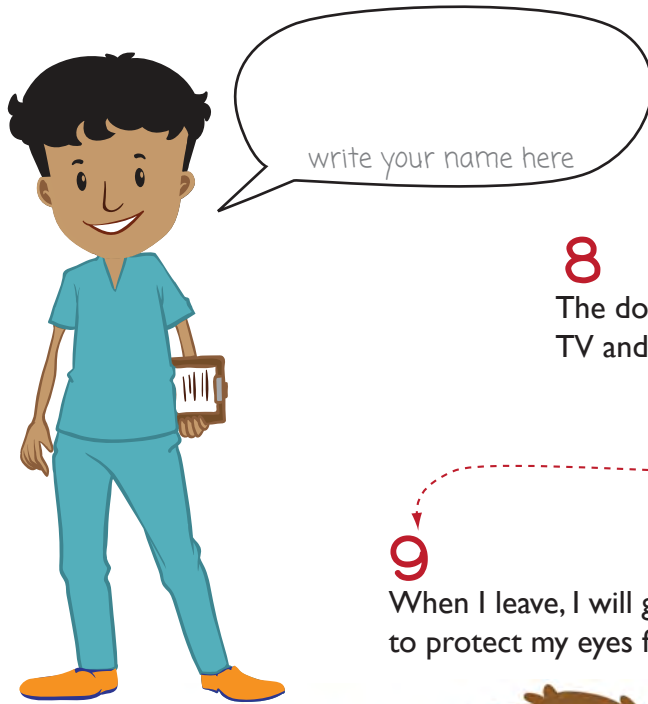
The eye drops have to set in my eyes, so I can go to the reception room and play.
