

## Texas Children's Credentialing Fees

**Summary:** Texas Children's Hospital has an open medical staff except for certain services who have approved exclusivities. No individual is entitled to appointment to the Medical Staff and must be reviewed and approved in accordance to the Bylaws and Credentialing policy of Texas Children's Hospital. Payment of Texas Children's Credentialing Fees entitles you to access the general benefits offered to the medical staff, including health and wellbeing services

**Medical Staff Statuses:** Medical Staff Statuses include Active, Consulting, Adjunct and Emeritus. A summary of qualifications, prerogatives, and limitations is listed below:

- Active Medical Staff
  - Includes admitting and attending privileges at Texas Children's Hospital facilities;
  - Patient Activity requirements include twelve (12) or more patient contacts within two (2) year appointment period;
  - Meeting Attendance requirements based on departmental direction.
- Consulting
  - Includes attending privileges at Texas Children's Hospital facilities but no admitting privileges;
  - No patient activity requirements;
  - No meeting attendance requirements.
- Adjunct
  - No Admitting/Attending privileges at Texas Children's Hospital facilities;
  - No patient activity requirements;
  - No meeting attendance requirements.
- Advanced Practice Providers
  - Must be sponsored by an Active/Courtesy/Consulting member of Texas Children's Medical Staff.
- Allied Health Professional
  - Must be sponsored by an Active/Courtesy/Consulting member of Texas Children's Medical Staff.
