How to Schedule a New Patient Appointment:

1. We begin accepting patients after they turn 19 years old.
2. Patients/families should call (713) 798-6333 and ask to speak to a **Transition Medicine Social Worker**.
3. The Social Worker will do an intake over the phone that takes about 20-25 minutes.
4. Patients/families will receive a follow-up call in the next 5-7 business days with the Transition Team's decision regarding a new patient appointment.

If an Appointment is scheduled, please bring these things to clinic:

Insurance

- Bring your health insurance card(s).
- Bring the names, telephone and fax numbers of your case worker/contact person for your:
 - **Home Health Agency**
 - **Medicaid Case Manager/Coordinator** and
 - **Waiver Programs (HCS, CLASS, CBA)**

Medications

- Bring your pharmacy phone number.
- Bring a list of all your medications. For **EACH** medication, include: **Name, Dose, and How Often** you take the medicine.
- Bring a copy of your insurance formulary (list of drugs they cover) or the website address for this
- Bring **ALL** equipment that you routinely need or use. For example, a suction machine, urinary catheters, Diastat for seizures, etc. The clinic does not have equipment like this.

Legal Documents

- Bring copies of your Guardianship paperwork.
- Bring copies of any Advanced Directives you may have.

Forms and Paperwork

- If you bring forms with you for the physician to fill out, we will send them 5-7 business days **AFTER** your visit. If you want us to fax the forms; bring this fax number with you.

***Please arrive to clinic at least 15 minutes before your scheduled appointment to complete the registration process.**
