

How to clear the cache using Google Chrome™

Objective:

To clear your history of temporarily stored images, scripts, and other website data while you are using your CME Tracker[™] Staff Edition.

Introduction:

Clearing your cache (deleting temporary internet files) is a step you will take when updating your CME Tracker[™] Staff Edition.

Method:

Step 1:

- a) Open Google Chrome[™] as your web browser. (Fig. A)
- b) Select the Chrome menu on the browser tool bar. (The 3 dots in the upper right corner.)

Step 3:

- a) In the **Clear browsing data** dialog box select **All time** from the **Time range** dropdown menu.
- b) Check all three options that display (Browsing history, Cookies, and Cached images).
- c) Select CLEAR DATA (Fig. C)
