Submission Deadline	December 1, 2015
Eligibility	Any individual affiliated with an academic institution may apply. Only original, unpublished data will be accepted. Previously published results are not eligible.
Guidelines	<p>Describe the objectives and results of the research in the abstract. Abstracts will be judged solely on the basis of the data in the submitted abstract.</p> <p>Limit title to 75 characters without spaces</p> <p>Abstracts should be presented in paragraphs: Background, Methods, Results, and Conclusions.</p> <p>Do not use proprietary names.</p> <p>Do not exceed 2500 characters without spaces, for the body of the abstract.</p> <p>Individuals may submit more than one abstract as first author.</p> <p>Limit the authors for each abstract to 10 individuals. All coauthors must meet the definition of authorship as stated by the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors in <i>the Uniform Requirements for Manuscripts Submitted to Biomedical Journals</i>.</p>
Travel award for abstracts	5 abstracts will be selected by the scientific committee and awarded 500 USD for travel expenses
Notifications	<p>Notifications will be sent to the corresponding authors by December 10th 2015</p> <p>8 oral presentations will be awarded.</p> <p>Presentations will be added to the appropriate session of the program.</p> <p>Length of presentation will be limited to 10 minutes.</p>
