Heart Safe School Program

Project ADAM helps schools nationwide implement programs to make automated external defibrillators (AEDs) readily available by preparing schools and community centers for a cardiac emergency through emergency response plans, staff CPR and AED training, student CPR education, and sudden cardiac arrest awareness education. Upon completion of the program, campuses will earn certification as a Heart Safe campus and will receive ongoing support from Project ADAM led by Texas Children's Hospital.
