Exam room

A medical assistant will check your vital signs, such as your weight, height, body temperature and blood pressure.



Cast room



You will have your cast removed. Sometimes there can be a short wait until a cast tech is available.

We use a very special tool to cut your cast off. The tool does not hurt and will not cut your skin.



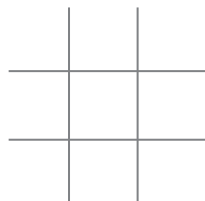
Scan to watch a video

Many patients need to stop here. The radiology team will take an X-ray. Sometimes there is a short wait until a radiology tech is available.

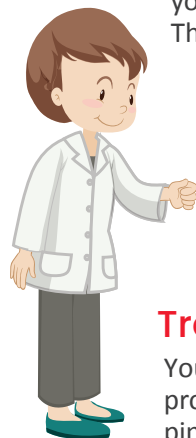

Exam room

The provider will ask questions about your child's healing and review the X-rays. They will decide what happens next.



Healing

If you need more time to heal, you may get a new cast.

Treatment

Your provider can provide a brace, remove pins, change bandages or other treatment.
