Texas Children's Pavilion for Women specializes in the care of women with high-risk pregnancies. We are known for expertly addressing the needs of mothers and babies throughout these complex pregnancies, and for the outcomes we achieve.

Our expansive program includes maternal-fetal medicine specialists, maternal-fetal medicine sonographers, fetal echo sonographers, certified diabetes educators, certified genetic counselors and offers a full spectrum of care from consultative and diagnostic services to comprehensive treatments that require the most advanced medical attention, treatment and surgery.

Our program also includes the Texas Children's Fetal Center,[®] where expectant families have access to specialists in fetal diagnostics and interventional therapies. The Fetal Center is one of only a few centers in the U.S. that is able to provide the full spectrum of fetal therapies, including treatment for hypoplastic left heart syndrome, congenital diaphragmatic hernia, lower urinary tract obstruction, and twin-twin transfusion syndrome, along with other life-threatening fetal conditions.

- **Placenta Accreta Spectrum** – Our Placenta Accreta Spectrum (PAS) program offers women a proven resource for the management of these rare, potentially life-threatening pregnancies. With risks that include the possibility of massive blood loss in the mother and premature birth, women with morbidly adherent placenta require specialized care from an experienced team – one that is well equipped to respond to complex challenges during pregnancy and delivery.
- **Maternal Heart** – Texas Children's Pavilion for Women is making pregnancy possible for women with heart disease through our Maternal Heart Program, an innovative program that optimizes safety and outcomes in these high-risk pregnancies.
- **Program for Multiples** – Our unique Program for Multiples offers women personalized services if pregnant with two or more babies such as a MFM consultation, comprehensive ultrasound, genetic counseling and testing and nutritional assessment.
- **Rheumatology Program** - Our collaborative team provides the highest quality of counseling and care to rheumatology patients for preconception and during pregnancy for women with rheumatic diseases such as Lupus and Rheumatoid Arthritis.
- **Renal Program** - Our Maternal Fetal Medicine and Nephrology specialists with Baylor College of Medicine treat and manage women with kidney disease, including women needing dialysis during pregnancy.
- **Neurology Program** - Our multispecialty team provides care for pregnant women with neurological conditions, both before and during pregnancy, such as multiple sclerosis and seizure disorders.


