Conditions we treat

- Anal incontinence
- Chronic urinary tract infections
- Difficulty with defecation
- Genital fistula (rectovaginal, vesicovaginal, urethrovaginal, unknown)
- Interstitial cystitis / painful bladder syndrome
- Mesh complications
- Pelvic organ prolapse (cystocele, rectocele, enterocele, uterine prolapse, vaginal vault prolapse, recurrent prolapse)
- Post childbirth issues (perineal lacerations, painful intercourse, urinary incontinence, fecal incontinence)
- Urethral diverticulum
- Urinary frequency / urgency (overactive bladder)
- Urinary incontinence (urge incontinence, stress incontinence, mixed incontinence)
- Voiding dysfunction (voiding difficulty, urinary retention)

- Urodynamic testing

Surgical

- Treatments for urinary incontinence, fecal incontinence, urethral diverticulum, mesh complications, genital fistula
- Vaginal, laparoscopic (including DaVinci robotic assisted) and abdominal approaches for pelvic organ prolapse
