Our Small Baby Unit Team have been on the forefront of clinical improvements, including innovations and improvements around the human factors in teamwork at delivery resuscitations. Dr. Sundgren has led quality improvement projects leveraging communication systems so that the OB team summons the right number of neonatology providers timely and efficiently to the delivery room. Dr. Sundgren's research has helped define the critical roles and decision support tools that help our resuscitation team perform its best.

In addition, the nation's top ranked pediatric cardiovascular program, the Texas Children's Heart Center® provides imperic state-of-the-art care to our ELBW patients. The interventional pediatric cardiology program performs over 1400 cardiac catheterizations procedures annually, including micropreeemies. Catheterization intervention techniques often allow for patients to have earlier interventions at smaller sizes when more invasive surgical interventions would not be possible.

### Leading in the field

Based on our research and expertise through systematic reviews, nutrients enhance preterm infants' immune status, optimize the microbiome, improve growth and development, and influence the risk of necrotizing enterocolitis (NEC), sepsis, and other outcomes. This led the team to develop ELBW specific nutritional guidelines.

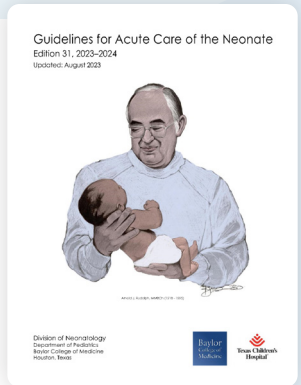
