Guidelines for Reproductive Health Referrals

Please review the following information closely before submitting your referral to ensure appropriateness of referral to adolescent medicine, and completeness of referral information. **Failure to adhere with the guidance below may result in patient care delays**.

Adolescent Medicine providers treat reproductive health concerns including:

- Abnormal uterine bleeding
- Dysmenorrhea
- Polycystic ovarian syndrome
- Desire for menstrual suppression
- Contraception

Any complaints warranting surgical intervention should be referred to Pediatric Gynecology.

Reproductive Health patients will be offered our first available appointment. The TCH Adolescent Medicine service does not currently have the availability to offer urgent visits for STI treatment. Please provide appropriate treatment for your patient's STI per CDC recommendations, or seek out an urgent STI treatment provider. Walk-in and scheduled appointments for STI treatment and other reproductive health concerns are available for patients aged 13-24 years through the Baylor Teen Health Clinics.
