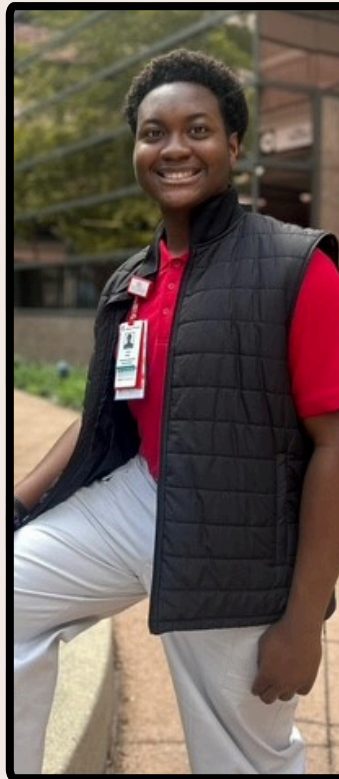
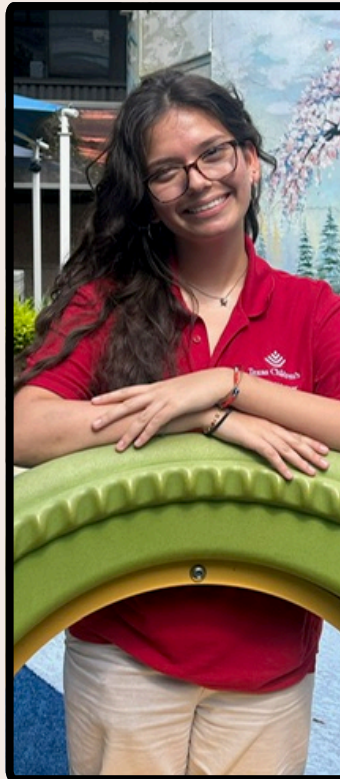

Program Details

Program Dates:

Friday, June 5, 2026 - Thursday, July 16, 2026

- The Summer Junior schedule is Monday - Thursday from 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.
- Junior volunteers will have four assignments and work two 3-hour shifts per day with a 1-hour lunch break.
- Weekend/evening and make-up shifts and NOT available.
- Junior volunteers are allowed up to 4 shift absences (2 full days). Exceeding absences could lead to dismissal from the program.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

Junior applicants must be at least 15 years of age by June 1, 2026.

Junior applicants must be enrolled in high school for the 2026-27 school year.

Junior volunteers are required to attend the mandatory in-person orientation and training on **Friday, June 5, 2026.**

All junior participants are expected to commit to participating in the entire summer program.

Application Process

Volunteers play a vital role in advancing the mission of Texas Children's by supporting patients and families with compassion and purpose. Guided by our HEART values, volunteers are expected to approach their service with professionalism, empathy, and commitment. Prospective volunteers are strongly encouraged to thoughtfully consider the time commitment and level of dedication required to ensure a meaningful and positive experience for the patients and families we serve.

To be considered for our #OneAmazingTeam of junior volunteers, applicants must:

1. Complete the online application
2. Submit two recommendation forms from two separate references.
3. Submit a **one-minute** video answering the following questions:
 - Which HEART value best represents a strength you bring as a volunteer, and which value do you hope to strengthen through this program?
 - What would you like us to know about you that shows why you would be a strong fit for the Summer Junior Volunteer Program?

The Summer Junior Program application will open on Friday, February 6, at 5 p.m. and close on Friday, February 13, at 5 p.m. Application, recommendation forms, and video **must** be received by Friday, February 13, at 5:00 p.m. CST to be considered for the program.



Video Submission Guidelines

As part of the Summer Junior application, all applicants must submit a 1-minute video answering the questions listed on this packet.

Before submitting your video, consider the following tips:

01



Record in a quiet location.
Avoid loud background
noise.

02



Refrain from filming
against a wall. Give
yourself plenty of space
from the background.

03



Lighting. Ensure you record
in a well-lit location

04



Upload your video as a .mov or
.mp4 file, or submit a link via
YouTube or Vimeo.

Videos submitted through
other platforms cannot be
viewed, and your application
will not be considered.

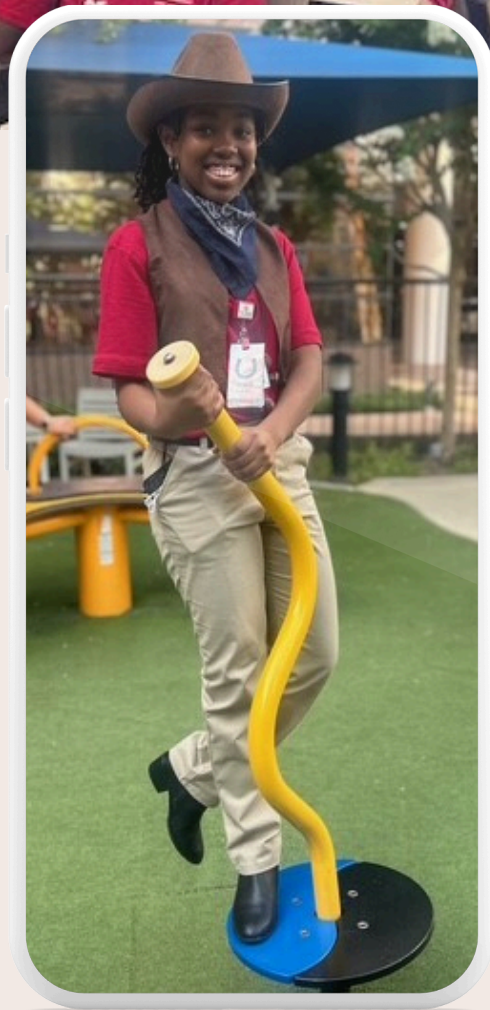

Health Requirements

If you are accepted into the program, Junior volunteers must also submit proof of the following immunization records:

- MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
- Varicella (Chicken Pox)
- TDAP (Pertussis)
- PPD (Tuberculosis Test)
