# PROGRAM DETAILS

## Program Dates:

**Monday, June 1, 2026 – Thursday, June 25, 2026**

- Schedule: Monday - Thursday from 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.
- Junior volunteers will have three to four assignments daily with a 30 minute lunch break Mondays and Wednesday. An hour Lunch & Learn on Tuesdays and Thursdays
- Junior Volunteers are permitted up to two absences.
- Weekend, evening or make-up shifts are NOT available.
- All Summer Juniors are expected to commit to participating for the entire duration of the program.

### Program guidelines

Junior applicant must be at least 15 years of age by June 1, 2026

Junior applicant must be enrolled in high school for the 2026-27 school year

Junior volunteers are required to attend the mandatory orientations dates: Monday, June 1<sup>st</sup> and Tuesday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>

# APPLICATION PROCESS

Prospective volunteers are strongly encouraged to thoughtfully consider the time commitment and level of dedication required to ensure a meaningful and positive experience for the patients and families we serve.

To be considered for our #OneAmazingTeam of junior volunteers, applicants must:

1. Complete the online application
2. Upload two recommendation letters from two separate references
3. Upload your most recent report card.

The Summer Junior Program application will open on Monday, February 9<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 a.m. and close on Friday, February 13<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 p.m.

All documents must be received by Wednesday, February 13<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 p.m. CST to be considered for the program.

# HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

If you are accepted into the program, Junior Volunteers must also complete the following requirements:

**Submit vaccination records, to include:**

- MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) - Two doses or laboratory evidence of immunity are required.
- Varicella (Chicken Pox) - Documentation of immunization, two (2) doses at appropriate intervals, or laboratory evidence of immunity. Only written physician documentation of disease history is acceptable.
- TDAP (Pertussis) - Documentation of at least one (1) dose of tetanus-diphtheria-pertussis (Tdap), then a Td booster every 10 years.
- PPD (Tuberculosis Test) - A negative TB skin test or a negative chest x-ray within the past year is required.
