The International and Destination Medicine team works on behalf of our patients and offers you many services to support your child and your family before, during and after your visit to Houston. Our team ensures that distance and language are not obstacles to receiving world-class care.

We understand that every patient has different needs and expectations. Our goal is to provide the most professional and personalized care to all our patients and their families. Our services includes, but are not limited to:

- Review of medical information by specialists
- Scheduling appointments with doctors, assisting with hospital admission procedures and arranging follow-up appointments
- Providing appointment reminders for all future appointments
- Provision of medical reports and treatment plans
- International Patient Coordinator visits to the patient/family during outpatient visits and inpatient stays
- Coordination with external companies to provide medical equipment
- Coordination between the family, local physicians in home country and Texas Children's Hospital staff in cases of direct hospitalization, complex medical cases, and/or follow-up purposes after completion of treatment

Medical Review

Once all necessary information is received, an International Patient Coordinator will facilitate assessment of the patient's medical needs by the appropriate consulting physician(s).
